Dear All

Following a request received from Councillor Sean Morgan, Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Regeneration Transportation and Sustainability, proposals have been developed to make Bwl Road one-way in a northerly direction between Lon-Y-Celyn and number 1 Brooklands Cottages (located near the B4255 Shingrig Road junction). A No Entry restriction is also proposed near number 4 Brooklands Cottages in order to prevent traffic from entering Bwl Road via the junction on the northern side of the grassed triangular island.

The proposed one-way arrangement would reduce the number of vehicles that currently use Bwl Road in order to access the A472 route via the Llwyncelyn Terrace junction. It would also enable the carriageway to be narrowed in order to facilitate a segregated area for pedestrians as there is currently no footway provision along the northern section of Bwl Road. Details of the proposals are shown in the attached drawing TM/2020/34.

If supported the traffic regulation order would initially be installed on an experimental basis to enable its impact to be assessed before any permanent scheme is taken forward. The experimental order would be in force for a maximum period of 18 months and would be monitored during that time. Any comments or objections received during the experiment would be fully considered by the Head of Infrastructure who could make amendments before deciding whether the order should be made permanent or revoked.

Prior to the experimental one-way being taken forward we are seeking your views on the experimental proposal. I would therefore be grateful if you could provide me with any comments that you may have by 1 June 2020.
