1907 To receive update on Summer Play from GAVO

The clerk appraised the Members of the latest e mail received from GAVO (copy of e mail provided in correspondence pack)

In summary GAVO were short of staff themselves but if they could overcome this issue they may be able to provide a play option but limited to under 2 hours per day.

1908 Receive presentation regarding Summer Sport (as an option to replace Summer Play)

The Chair welcomed Ben Hammond (CCBC Sports Development)

Ben provided details of a Sport option that could be provided by CBC as an alternative to the previous summer Play Scheme

They could provide coaches who would cover a variety of sports for the period 1st August to 26th August (4 weeks) .

They could accommodate ages 8 - 13 both male and female (and they could provide male and female coaches)

They would provide all equipment required, were all DBS checked, first aid trained and would provide Risk assessments for all activities.

The cost would be £15 per hour and they could accommodate the requirements of the Community Council e.g. 10 am to 3 pm or 10 am to 2 pm (30 minutes earlier for registration) and they could provide the relevant number of coaches (2 coaches for up to 35 children or 3 coaches if the numbers were higher)

It was agreed we would let him know if we wished to proceed with this option before the Witsun Holidays.

It was agreed the 50p per day charge would be levied

A discussion took place on possible venues with the School probably being preferred as it could offer in indoor facility with the field behind (if we could agree its use) for outdoor sports. **Clerk to write to school**
