2512 To consider the Property Condition Survey update provided by CCBC

Members were informed that due to the technical nature of some of the work CCBC Property Services had been asked to obtain quotations. They have confirmed their contractors were stretched at present dealing with the aftermath of the floods and storms but they would attempt to engage contractors when they became available. Members were reminded that repairs exceeding £100,000 had been identified (accepting they could be

spread over a number of years) but it certainly exceeded the budget currently allocated and it was important to prioritise expenditure in future years so the necessary works can be undertaken.

Cllr Miles reported she had asked for an extension to the period for the submission of the Business Plan. Cllr Miles also reported on the consultation results. Agreed to hold a public meeting to gauge public support for re-opening the facility.

It was also agreed to contact local businesses to seek financial support for the of the Toilet. It was noted that any support would need to be longer term to ensure sustainability.
